or can provide proof that they are covered by Person Liability Insurance Cover of at least \$10,000,000

Conditions of entry:

1. **Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.**
2. The organising Committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition, divide any class, alter times, change arenas, or alter an event.
3. Neither the organising committee nor the Pony Club Association of Victoria accepts liability for any accident, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any person or property whatsoever.
4. Gear check is required before the first class and after any change in gear for both PC and Open riders.
5. Competitor numbers - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers on the draw. Competitors may supply their own numbers (– but it is not a requirement)
6. Queries, protests, horse abuse rules as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
7. Horses must be at least 4 years old, no stallions, colts or rigs
8. More than one horse may be ridden subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of By-laws multiple horse rules.
9. The organising committee may accept none, one or more of the entries, at its sole discretion
10. PCV membership cards (2) to be handed in at the Secretary's office before riding,
11. Medical armbands are optional.
12. Correct 'standards' numbered helmet must be worn as specified in PCV Gear Rules. Spot checks may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination.
13. Lunging will not be available
14. Campers must use the cattle yards provided - at \$10 per yard - book via entries@wodongaponyclub.org.au
15. Dogs allowed but must be on a leash at all times
16. Equality of Scores will be separated as per Handbook of Bylaws, Show-jumping Bylaw 38.3.a
17. Championship Scoring to be used
18. Yards must be of solid construction as per PCV rules
